So far, four million pounds of landscape debris have been collected in the university's road to recovery. Today, power has been restored, residence halls have reopened, classes have resumed, and the university is coming to life again.

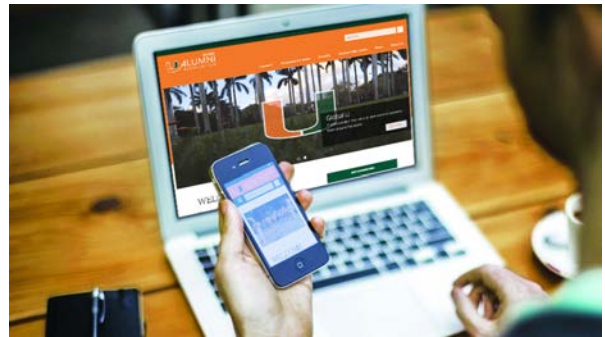
